The Heritage of the Perfect Sports Car

"The philosophy of the company is as unique as its cars. Every model that bears the Porsche crest on the hood must combine sporting performance with everyday usability. It's this intelligent combination of design, performance and efficiency that makes Porsche cars so special."

As manager of the Historical Archives of Porsche AG with the responsibility for the heritage of the Porsche brand, Dieter Landenberger, is perfectly placed to tell us about Porsche's design DNA and the key role the 911 model has played in the company's goal of creating the perfect sports car.

"For more than half a century the Porsche 911 has been revered as an iconic automobile and the very epitome of the sports car. The 911 has consistently gone its own way, not only in terms of design, but also with regard to technology. The timeless design of the 911 series is undoubtedly a vital element of that legacy; it blends emotion with functionality.

"The Porsche designers responsible for the seven 911 generations so far have been consistently indifferent to passing fads. On the contrary, the design has been continuously evolved taking great care to preserve its unique identity. 'Form follows function' has been a natural guiding principle throughout."

L'héritage de la voiture de sport idéale

◀ "In the course of the last fifty years our engineers have regularly reinvented the 911. With innovations such as the three-spoke safety steering wheel (1963), Targa roll bar (1965), internally ventilated disk brakes (1966), front and rear spoilers (1972), exhaust gas turbocharger (1974), hot-dip galvanized body shell (1975), intercooler (1977), Digital Motor Electronics (1983), Tiptronic (1989), aluminum chassis (1993), On-Board Diagnosis (1995), ceramic brake disks (2001), dual clutch transmission (2008), or seven-speed manual transmission (2011)—the 911 has repeatedly set new technological benchmarks.

"The 911 has always been committed to the performance principle and motor racing is its most important test lab. From the very beginning, it has been at home on circuits all over the world, earning itself a reputation as a versatile and reliable winning vehicle. It should come as no surprise to learn that a good two-thirds of Porsche's tally of 30,000 race victories to date were notched up by the 911."

"With the new 911 GT3 RS, Porsche continues the heritage of street-legal, high-performance models. For the Porsche brand these models are very important.

With their extraordinary performance and sportiness they are pure drivers' cars. The new 911 GT3 RS maintains the basic idea of Ferry Porsche who once said: 'Driving enjoyment is not created by comfort, but quite the opposite.'" ✖

« Au cours des cinquante dernières années, nos ingénieurs ont régulièrement réinventé la 911. Avec des innovations telles que le volant de sécurité à trois rayons (1963), l'arceau Targa (1965), les freins à disque à ventilation interne (1966), les becquets avant et arrière (1972), le turbocompresseur à gaz d'échappement (1974), la carrosserie en acier galvanisé à chaud (1975), le refroidisseur intermédiaire (1977), la gestion moteur numérique (DME) (1983), la boîte de vitesses Tiptronic (1989), le châssis en aluminium (1993), le diagnostic embarqué (1995), les plaquettes de frein en céramique (2001), la boîte de vitesses à double embrayage (2008), ou la transmission manuelle à 7 rapports (2011), la 911 a marqué de nouvelles étapes technologiques en permanence.

La 911 a toujours été fidèle au principe de performance et la course automobile est son laboratoire d'essai le plus important. Depuis le tout début, elle a été à l'aise sur les circuits du monde entier, se faisant une réputation de voiture performante, polyvalente et fiable. Il n'est donc pas surprenant de constater que les deux tiers des 30 000 victoires en course de Porsche à ce jour ont été remportés par la 911.

Avec la nouvelle 911 GT3 RS, Porsche poursuit cet héritage de modèles homologués pour la route et hautement performants. Pour la marque Porsche, ces modèles sont très importants.

Avec leur performance extraordinaire et leur côté sportif, ce sont des voitures destinées aux conducteurs passionnés. La nouvelle 911 GT3 RS maintient l'idée de base de Ferry Porsche qui a déclaré un jour : "Le plaisir de la conduite n'est pas créé par le confort, bien au contraire." » ✖

Designing Perfection

If the address 'Porsche Straße 911' is not enough in itself, the roaring sounds from the nearby test track will soon convince you that the Porsche Development Center at Weissach, close to Stuttgart, is a very special place. This is where all Porsches are designed and tested, and concepts like the Porsche 911 GT3 RS are refined to perfection by the Head of GT Cars, Andreas Preuninger, and his team of designers, engineers and mechanics.

As the leader of the team responsible for the current range of GT cars at Porsche, there is no one better than Mr Preuninger to describe why the latest Porsche 911 GT3 RS is such a special driving experience.

"First of all, the base car we start from—the 911—is without a doubt the best driver's car in the world. Secondly, we shouldn't forget that we make the car better for the specific needs of our special target group and not necessarily for everybody. The focus is to make the car a true driver's car without having to care about all the compromises a more all-round sports car has to consider."

Concevoir la perfection

Si l'adresse « Porsche Straße 911 » ne suffit pas en elle-même, les vrombissements du circuit de test à proximité montrent rapidement que le Centre de développement Porsche à Weissach, à proximité de Stuttgart, est un endroit très spécial. C'est le lieu où toutes les Porsche sont conçues et testées et où des concepts tels que celui de la Porsche 911 GT3 RS sont raffinés à la perfection par le chef de la division des voitures GT, Andreas Preuninger, et son équipe de concepteurs, d'ingénieurs et de mécaniciens.

En tant que chef de l'équipe responsable de la gamme actuelle de voitures GT chez Porsche, M. Preuninger est le mieux placé pour expliquer pourquoi la Porsche 911 GT3 RS offre une expérience de conduite si spéciale.

« Tout d'abord, la voiture de base avec laquelle nous commençons, la 911, est sans aucun doute la meilleure voiture du monde. Deuxièmement, nous ne devons pas oublier que nous améliorons la voiture pour les besoins spécifiques de notre groupe cible spécial et pas nécessairement pour tout le monde. L'objectif est de faire de cette voiture une vraie voiture de conducteur sans avoir à se préoccuper de tous les compromis associés à une voiture de sport plus générique. »

- “The car has to transmit a lot of information to the driver, melt into one with him and give him that seat-of-the-pants feeling; it has to become his prolonged arm. Another important point is the mechanical character of all the technology involved; it's not a bad thing if you feel and hear the valves hissing, gears turning or even whining, that gives the car identity and character... Some edges here and there are welcome in a true motoring car.”

“It's important for us that the car has to be pleasing to the eye, while also looking purposeful and mildly aggressive... But all the components have to function efficiently to make the car perform as well as possible. It's 'form follows function', but only if the form looks cool, if you know what I mean.”

So what did Mr Preuninger think when he saw the final LEGO Technic version of his car? “I was astonished about how much resemblance could be achieved to the real car just using LEGO components. The specific creases in the hood and roof, the openings in the fenders, the big wing and air intakes are all there, so you can see at first glance this is an RS. The way working features such as the paddle-shift PDK gearing system have been integrated into the model is just amazing.”

Un autre point important est le caractère mécanique de toute la technologie impliquée. Ce n'est pas une mauvaise chose si vous sentez et que vous entendez les valves siffler, les engrenages tourner, ou même grincer, cela donne une identité et un caractère à la voiture... Des caractéristiques de ce type ici et là sont bienvenues dans une vraie voiture de sport.

Il est important pour nous que la voiture soit agréable à regarder, tout en ayant aussi l'air déterminée et légèrement agressive... Mais tous les composants doivent fonctionner efficacement pour que la voiture soit aussi performante que possible. “La forme suit la fonction”, mais seulement si la forme est cool, si vous voyez ce que je veux dire. »

Qu'a donc pensé M. Preuninger quand il a vu la version LEGO Technic finale de sa voiture ? « J'ai été stupéfait de voir à quel point elle pouvait ressembler autant à la vraie voiture seulement en utilisant des composants LEGO. Les rainures spécifiques dans le capot et le toit, les ouvertures des ailes, le grand aileron et les prises d'air, tout est là, et l'on peut voir du premier coup d'œil que c'est une RS. La façon dont des caractéristiques fonctionnelles, notamment le système de changement de vitesse PDK, ont été intégrées au modèle est tout simplement incroyable. »

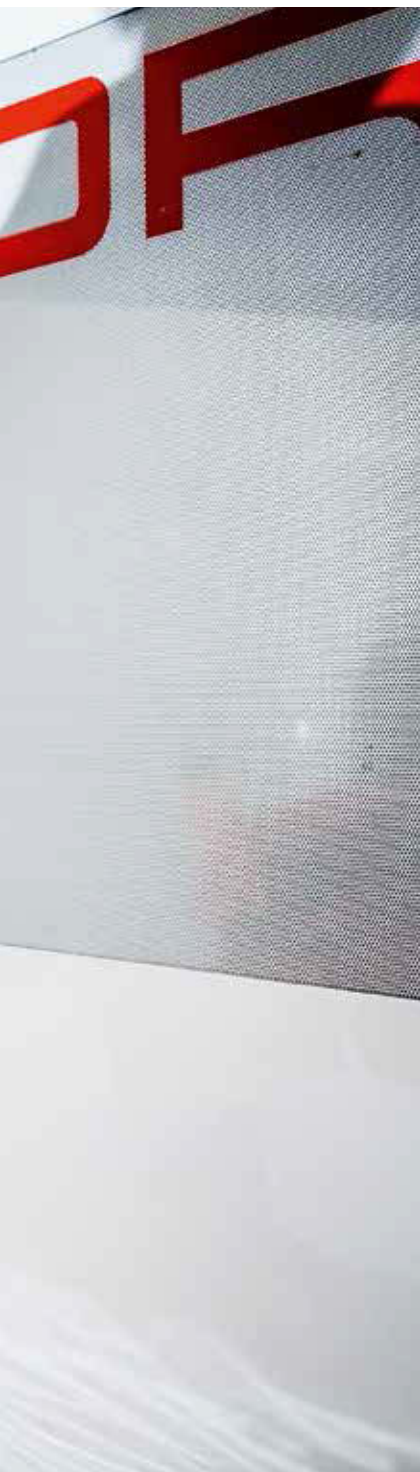

The Driver's Point of View

It may seem a long way from the karting tracks in his native New Zealand to the professional race circuits of Le Mans and Daytona, but for racing driver Brendon Hartley the goal has always been the same: "I want to win. In everything I do."

As a Porsche Works driver and a member of one of the most successful endurance racing teams competing today, the 26-year-old lives and breathes for anything with four wheels and an engine.

Brendon clearly remembers his first impressions of a car that has often been described as the closest you can get to a race car for the road: "The 911 GT3 RS is the first road car I have driven that gave me goose pimples. I only drove it from Weissach to a hotel down the road, but all my senses were overloaded with joy: the sound, the vibration when the revs got close to the red line, the feeling

En tant que pilote de l'équipe officielle Porsche et membre de l'une des meilleures équipes de course d'endurance, ce pilote de 26 ans se passionne pour tout ce qui a quatre roues et un moteur.

Brendon se souvient clairement de ses premières impressions d'une voiture souvent décrite comme ce qui se rapproche le plus d'une voiture de course pour la route : « La 911 GT3 RS est la première voiture de route qui m'a donné des frissons quand je l'ai conduite. Je l'ai conduite seulement de Weissach à un hôtel pas très loin, mais tous mes sens débordaient de joie : le son, la vibration quand elle s'approche du plein régime, la sensation de la route transmise par le volant, la position basse, comme une voiture de course, tout m'a rappelé l'excitation d'être dans une voiture de course, et pourtant je peux la prendre pour aller faire mes courses ! »

of the road through the steering wheel, the low, race-car-like position—it all gave me flash backs of the thrills of being in a race car, yet I could take this down the road for the grocery shopping!

"The car has more down-force, more mechanical grip from the tires, more horsepower and more muscle, which means it's hard for anybody not to do a double-take as it passes."

His meeting with the LEGO Technic version of the car was also a positive experience, and one that brought back memories of his childhood: "It's amazing. My brother and I were big LEGO enthusiasts as kids, so when I saw this I immediately thought of all the fun I would have pulling it apart and putting it back together. After the initial delight at the way it looked and the fact that they could really convey the lines of the 911 GT3 RS with standard LEGO Technic parts, I was then impressed to see a fully working gearbox and engine."

"My only question after that was: when can I have one?"

Après la joie initiale en découvrant son aspect et le fait que l'on pouvait vraiment reproduire les lignes de la 911 GT3 RS avec des pièces LEGO Technic standard, j'ai aussi été impressionné de découvrir une boîte de vitesses et un moteur qui fonctionnent.

Ma seule question après ça : quand puis-je en avoir une ? »

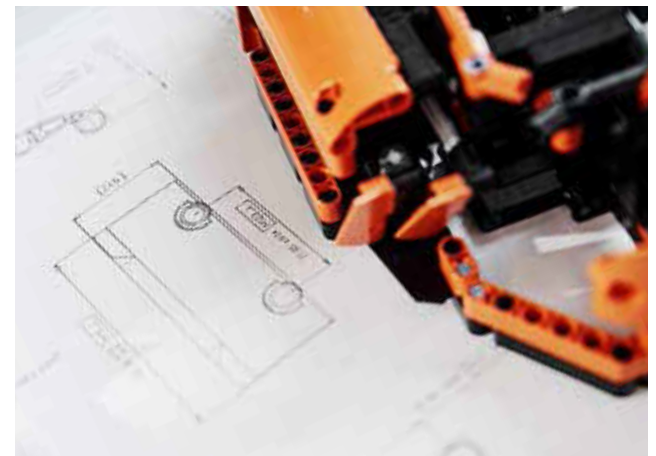
Un projet de rêve

➔ "Based only on images, we started the development of our first model. This was presented to the 911 GT3 RS design team at Porsche, who gave feedback on the important design features that define the iconic 911 shape.

"We developed the next model based on this feedback and also started the development of the wheels, which are an iconic part of the design of the car.

"About a month later we visited the 911 GT3 RS design team at the Porsche Development Center in Weissach. Here we presented our model to Andreas Preuninger, Head of GT Cars, and had a good discussion on the challenges of creating a 911 and specifically his team's 911 GT3 RS in LEGO elements. We had the opportunity to demonstrate all the technical features and got feedback on the functions Mr Preuninger wished to see in the model, and in which areas he felt the car's styling could be improved.

"Then we went to the Porsche GT workshop area to see a preproduction 911 GT3 RS complete and finished in lava orange. This was the first time we saw the car in color —all the others had been black, which Porsche uses intentionally to make it difficult to see the proportions and details of the car."

« Nous avons commencé le développement de notre premier modèle uniquement à partir d'images. Il a été présenté à l'équipe de conception de la 911 GT3 RS chez Porsche, qui a fait des commentaires sur les éléments de design importants qui définissent la célèbre forme de la 911.

Nous avons conçu le modèle suivant à partir de ces commentaires et nous avons aussi commencé le développement des roues qui sont une partie célèbre du design de la voiture.

Environ un mois plus tard, nous avons rendu visite à l'équipe de conception de la 911 GT3 RS au Centre de développement Porsche à Weissach. Nous avons alors présenté notre modèle à Andreas Preuninger, chef de la division des voitures GT, et nous avons eu une importante discussion sur les défis posés par la création d'une 911 avec des éléments LEGO, et plus particulièrement de la 911 GT3 RS de son équipe. Nous avons eu la possibilité de démontrer toutes les fonctions techniques et nous avons reçu des commentaires sur les fonctions que M. Preuninger souhaitait voir dans ce modèle, et sur les aspects de la voiture qui pouvaient être améliorés.

Nous sommes allés ensuite dans l'atelier des Porsche GT pour voir un modèle de présérie terminé de la 911 GT3 RS orange fusion. C'était la première fois que nous voyions la voiture en couleur. Toutes les autres étaient noires, il était donc plus difficile de voir les proportions et les détails de la voiture. »

« Back in Billund at LEGO Group HQ we started the development of the wing elements, as it became clear we needed a more defined outline to the wheel arch area of the car, both front and rear. This was one of our biggest challenges, as we needed to design an element to work on the 911 GT3 RS but also to be a LEGO Technic element that would work with all our other elements and be something that could work in our system for years to come.

“On returning from Porsche, the real hard work of the project began—the graphic designer started working on the required decorations and stickers, the model designer worked further on the styling using the new elements to great effect. This was an extremely difficult stage for the development of the gearbox and the designer went through many different versions before we ended up developing one last new element to make the gearbox run smoothly.

“The next big step was the final approval at Porsche. We got it. And after months of exciting work it was great to stand with such an accurate, function-filled model of one of the most iconic cars in the world—and to have it signed off by the designers and engineers of the real thing. A fantastic feeling all round.”

« De retour à Billund au siège social du Groupe LEGO, nous avons commencé le développement des ailes, car il était évident que nous avions besoin d'un contour plus défini de la zone du passage de roues de la voiture, à l'avant et à l'arrière. Cela a été l'un de nos plus grands défis, car nous devions concevoir un élément LEGO Technic qui conviendrait à la 911 GT3 RS mais qui fonctionnerait aussi avec tous nos autres éléments, de sorte que nous puissions l'utiliser pendant des années.

Après notre visite chez Porsche, le travail vraiment ardu sur le projet a commencé : le graphiste a commencé à travailler sur les décorations et les autocollants, et le designer de modèles a travaillé davantage sur le stylisme en utilisant les nouveaux éléments pour créer un excellent effet. Cette étape s'est avérée extrêmement difficile pour le développement de la boîte de vitesses. Le designer a créé de nombreuses versions différentes avant que nous ne finissions par développer un nouvel élément qui a permis à la boîte de vitesses de fonctionner correctement.

La grande étape suivante a été l'approbation finale de Porsche. Nous l'avons obtenue. Après des mois de travail passionnant, c'était fantastique d'avoir réalisé un modèle aussi précis et plein de fonctions de l'une des voitures les plus célèbres du monde, et qu'il soit approuvé par les concepteurs et les ingénieurs de la vraie voiture. C'était vraiment une sensation formidable. »

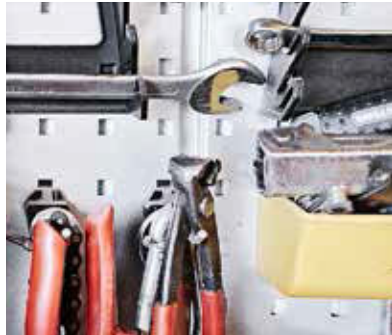

A Passion for Detail

A quick look at Senior LEGO Designer Uwe Wabra's own garage clearly shows that this is someone who is into anything mechanical that can be taken apart and assembled again. Cars, motorbikes, mopeds, bicycles—pretty much everything that is mechanical and on wheels. Mix his hobbies with his 19 years of experience as a LEGO product designer, and it's easy to see why the Porsche 911 GT3 RS project landed on his desk in the LEGO Technic designer team.

"It was fantastic to get the opportunity to work on the Porsche project, but also a real challenge. As Porsche's 911 GT3 RS project was still top secret at the time, I had to build the first Technic version from 'spy-photos' from the Internet.

"I did the first prototype in a matter of weeks. We then took it to Porsche and got great feedback from the 911 GT3 RS team on both the

"I really wanted to incorporate as many of the unique design details from the real car as possible, especially the shape of the bonnet and roof, the air-intakes and not least the low, sloping angle of the car.

"It was also important to integrate as many of the advanced technical functionalities from the real 911 GT3 RS as we could. The steering and suspension were difficult enough, but the biggest challenge was to create the functioning paddle-shift PDK gearing system.

"I am really proud of the finished model—it's great that we managed to give the LEGO Technic model the genuine 911 silhouette design-line and add so many advanced technical features." ✖

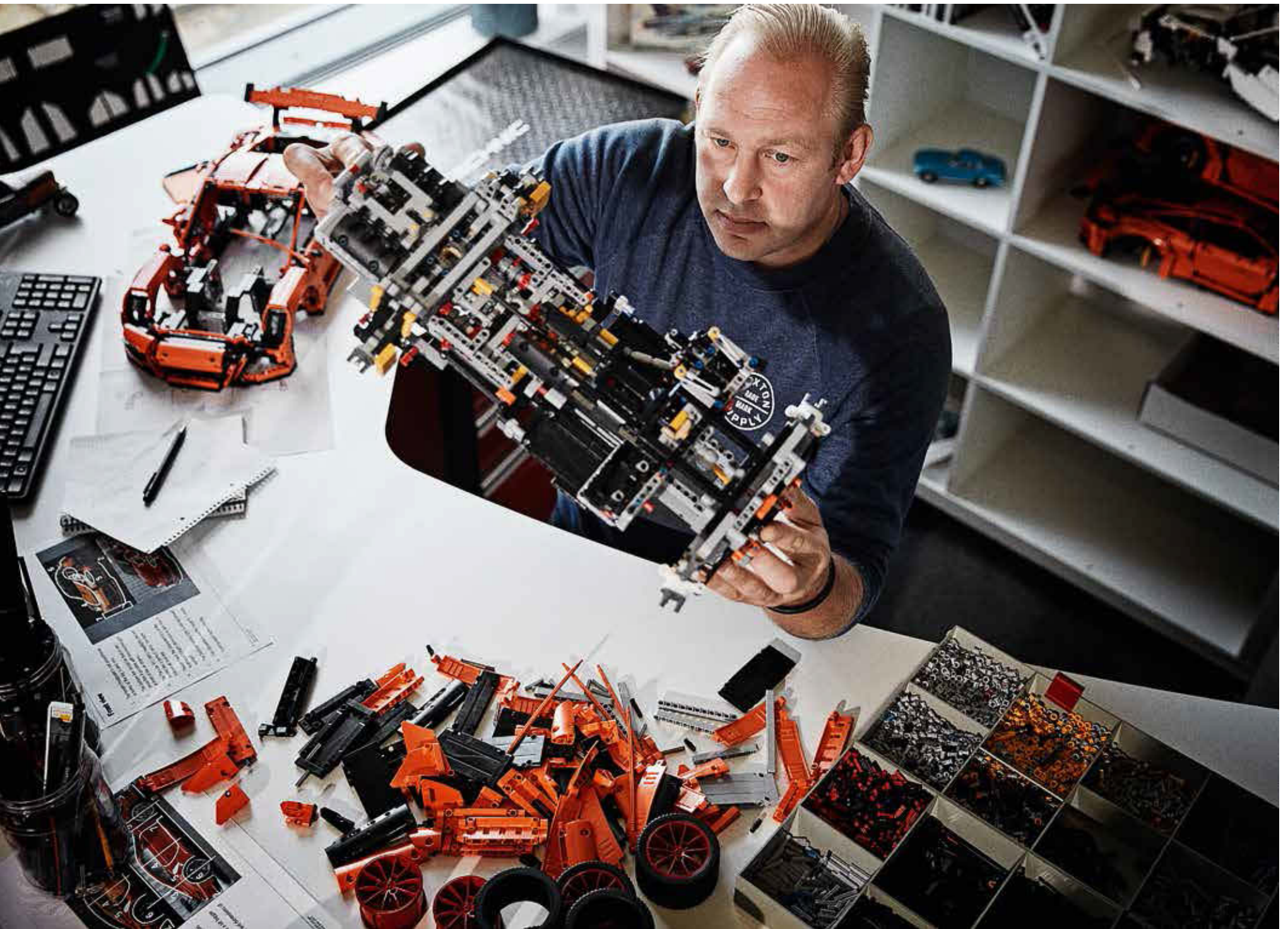

A LEGO® Memory

"This is *exactly* the one," is the immediate comment from Dr. Frank-Steffen Walliser, VP Motorsports and GT Cars at Porsche. Just returned from a victorious Porsche race weekend in the US, Dr. Walliser is pointing at an early LEGO Technic model launched in 1980 that's placed on his desk in his office.

"LEGO was a big part of my childhood. I had several LEGO models and I think I got this specific one as a Christmas present when I was about 11 years old. I still remember all its details and technical features," says Dr. Walliser, while proving his LEGO knowledge by discretely pointing out that one of the wheels on the model has been mounted the wrong way round.

"I actually made a small mistake when assembling the boxer engine. I couldn't make the pistons work properly even though I took the model apart and assembled it over and over again. My friend had the same model and his worked perfectly fine so I knew it could and should work smoothly. It nagged me for months until I got hold of the model again and finally made it work as it was supposed to.

"This LEGO Technic model was part of defining my interest in cars and later, as a teenager, helped push my education and career in the direction of technical engineering."

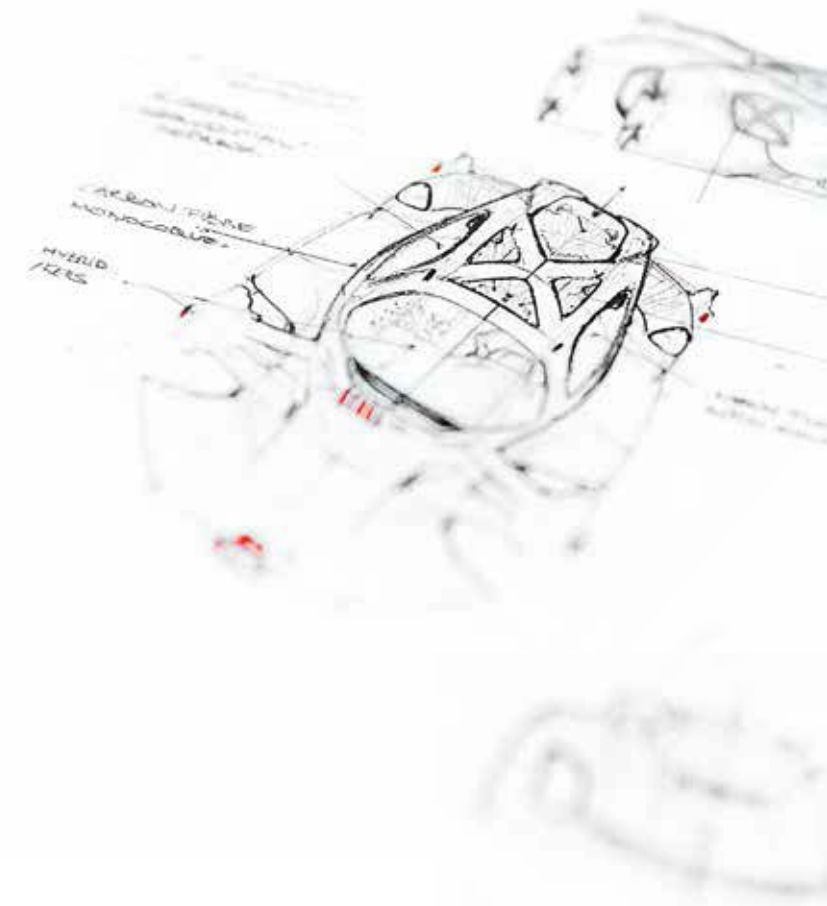

➤ "I am glad to see how my own kids have picked up on LEGO and LEGO Technic. My son got his first Technic set around the age of six. He is completely into it and I like the fact that it helps his understanding of how things function mechanically.

"We have a standard procedure when the kids and I begin building a new LEGO set. We sit down, closely study the box and the building instructions, and then we start sorting the bricks by color, form and function. After that we start the actual building. For us the building of the model is play in itself.

"Looking at the LEGO Technic Porsche 911 GT3 RS model, I'm impressed that they have managed to create the distinct curved lines of the Porsche 911. I know how difficult it is to shape the softer lines with LEGO elements.

"It is great to experience the level of detail and all the working parts in the model. The functioning PDK gear is especially impressive. And I like that everything is there, even if it is eventually hidden away—just like in the real car.

"At Porsche, a car is not just a car: it's all about the design, the performance, the sense of detail and, not least, the passion and dedication. I really feel that those things are here when you look at the LEGO model." ✖

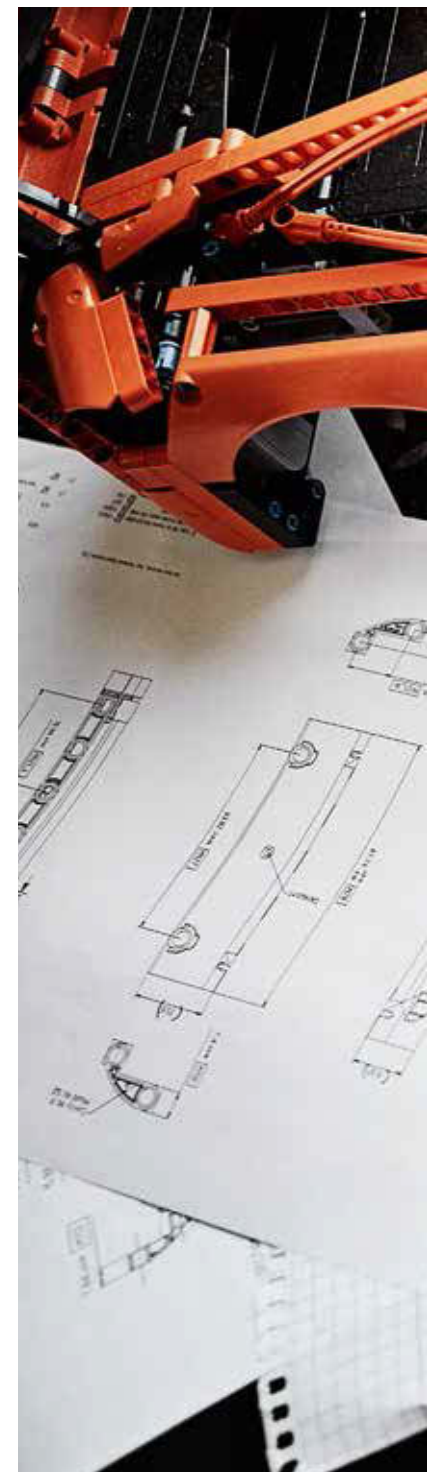

Producing Excellence

With more than 25 years of experience at Porsche, and the last three years as Plant Manager, Wolfgang Reiß is the most knowledgeable person to explain the challenges of constructing a car like the Porsche 911 GT3 RS.

"It's a special car and it takes a number of unique processes to ensure that the 2700 larger individual elements that go into the 911 GT3 RS come precisely together," says Mr Reiß. He explains that it takes four full days to assemble a Porsche 911 GT3 RS on the production line at the factory in Stuttgart and that the car will pass through the skilled hands of more than 600 specialists as it is assembled.

Interrogé sur les problèmes spécifiques qu'ils ont avec le processus de construction de la 911 GT3 RS, M. Reiß souligne le ➔

Asked to describe the specific issues they have with the 911 GT3 RS construction process, Mr Reiß highlights the luggage compartment lid, spoiler and especially the fenders as unique for this model, and the rollover bar as an option.

"Normally the complete body of the car is assembled with fenders for spraying. With the 911 GT3 RS the special fenders, with their integrated outlets, are not fitted to the body during the paint shop. This gives us a special challenge later when trying to ensure a uniform gap between the door and fender.

"The so-called 'marriage' is the magic moment in the Porsche production process. It's where the heart of the car—the engine—is mounted to rest on the drivetrain and the body is lowered for final assembly. It's a piece of logistic excellence to have these central components meet and merge at one spot on the assembly line within a matter of seconds."

Asked for his reaction on seeing the LEGO Technic version of the 911 GT3 RS for the first time, Mr Reiß states, "It's clear our two companies share the same dedication to detail. It's exciting to see how far LEGO has developed since my brother and I built simple cars with LEGO when we were young boys over 40 years ago." 🚗
